HENRY ROE


Henry was born in Lenton, Nottingham in 1842.

His second appointment was to Maidenhead in 1866.

In 1869 he married his childhood sweetheart Elizabeth Holmes and the following year they set sail for Fernando Po where their first child was born and died.

Henry wrote a number of books about his African experiences:-"West African Scenes" "Going to Africa", "Amos Deer", the "Fernando Po Mission",

He died in October 1920 after hurrying to catch a train in St.Ives, where he is buried.
